### 107.3.1.2 Minimum Lot Area and Setbacks

The minimum lot areas are as follows:
A. Six thousand two hundred fifty square feet of useable space for a single-family dwelling;
B. For each two-family building site, a minimum of nine thousand three hundred seventy-five square feet of useable space is required; and
C. Three thousand one hundred twenty-five square feet of usable space for each additional dwelling unit.
D. Residential setbacks are $20^{\prime}$ for the front property line, $5^{\prime}$ from the back property line, and $5^{\prime}$ from the side property line.
E. Business setbacks are $8^{\prime}$ from the front property line and $10^{\prime}$ from the back property line.
F. The business district located on Main Street from $4^{\text {th }}$ Street to $6^{\text {th }}$ Street is $0^{\prime}$.
